



## **Mike Rolecki Biography**

Mike Rolecki established JMR Program Management (JMRPM) LLC in 2014. As owner of JMRPM, a small business located in Southeastern Pennsylvania, Mike is focused on government contracts, proposal management, program management, and systems engineering. Mike applies Program Management and System Engineering practices to help businesses propose and initiate successful programs, guide programs to a successful life cycle, and help struggling programs optimize their performance. Mike helps his customers develop program processes and initiate a continuous process improvement environment.

Prior to initiating JMRPM, Mike enjoyed a 32 year career with The Boeing Company where he held a variety of leadership and engineering positions. During his last six years at Boeing, Mike was the V-22 Executive Program Director. As Program Manager of a CAT 1A program, he led a team of 1,100 people to execute \$1.3B/year in aircraft development and production programs that produced three high-technology aircraft per month. His responsibilities included program profit and loss, execution and integration of engineering changes into the production line, production performance, supplier management, and integration of supportability products. During his tenure as V-22 Program manager, Mike and his team reduced basic factory labor hours by approximately 20%.

Mike was V-22 Director of Engineering for three years and has an extensive engineering background. He led aircraft cross-functional Integrated Product Teams (IPTs) of approximately 400 employees and was responsible for technical execution of all hardware and software changes to the V-22 structure, integrated avionics and flight control systems.

Through Mike's career with Boeing, he served in several leadership and engineering positions including CV-22 (Air Force Special Operations) Program Manager, V-22 Avionics and Crew Systems Team Leader, V-22 Communications and Sensors Team Leader, and Flight Test Engineer on the venerable B-1B Lancer, F-18 Hornet and AV-8B Harrier.

Mike has a Bachelor's Degree in Aerospace Engineering from The University of Michigan and a Master's Degree in Business and Finance Management from Villanova University. Mike has also studied Systems Engineering Management at the University of Alabama, Huntsville.

Mike has served as member of the YMCA Board of Directors and is a member of the American Helicopter Society (AHS), Army Aviation Association of America (AAAA), the National Defense Industry Association (NDIA) and Women In Defense (WID) organizations.
