

**Vinnie Cervellieri, Contract Specialist – Audit Support  
Contracts Department, Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR)

Mr. Cervellieri currently serves as a Contract Specialist in the Audit Support function for NAVAIR, NAWCAD, Lakehurst Contracts Department since 2013. He is responsible for providing the Contracts Department with audit support in terms of on-the-spot personal consultation and advice in connection with the analysis of contractor cost representations and other related procurement/financial matters.

Mr. Cervellieri's professional background includes over 33 years of federal contracting experience in pre award/post award contract procurement matters including the interpretation and application of the cost accounting standards (CAS) and selected areas of the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and various supplements; along with significant experience in preparing and evaluating cost proposals, company-wide indirect rate structures, forward pricing rate proposals and accounting/billing/estimating systems.

Prior to his return to federal civil service Mr. Cervellieri served as Vice President of Finance and Administration and one of three shareholders/equity owners of a small business defense contractor. Earlier defense industry experience was acquired in corporate management positions including (i) Associate Director of Internal Audit and Federal Contract Audit at Imo Industries, Inc. a Fortune 500 Company engaged in the night vision segment of the defense industry, (ii) Manager of Government Accounting and corporate in-house government contract accounting consultant at the Ingersoll-Rand Company and (iii) Manager of Government Contract Audit at AlliedSignal Corporation. Additional experience was developed while employed in public accounting and also with the Defense Contract Audit Agency at the Branch, Sub Office and Regional Office levels.

Mr. Cervellieri is currently enrolled in the Doctor of Business Administration (DBA) Program, with a planned emphasis in federal contract accounting and procurement, at Felician University in Lodi, New Jersey. He earned an MBA degree from Auburn University, an MS degree in Contract & Acquisition Management from Florida Institute of Technology, a BS degree in Accounting from Saint Peter's College; while also earning the professional designation of Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE) and Level II certification in Contracting. He is a member of the National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA) and the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners.

While serving in the Audit Function within the Contracts Department, Mr. Cervellieri has received five departmental performance awards. Additional performance awards were earned while employed with the Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) as a Technical Specialist on the DCAA Mid-Atlantic Regional Labor Audit/Executive Compensation Teams, and a key witness in several successful federal court proceedings.

Mr. Cervellieri is a service-connected disabled veteran. He served aboard the USS Power, DD839 and at several other duty stations. He completed his five year active duty tour and was honorably discharged in 1979.
