## The NEW sam.gov

- SAM.gov is where users register to do business with the federal government, find exclusion records, and perform other tasks.
- The Integrated Award Environment (IAE) is preparing to merge SAM.gov, IAE's largest system, into the modernized [beta.SAM.gov](#) environment on May 24, 2021.
- Legacy SAM.gov will be decommissioned and the new environment will retire the "beta" and be renamed SAM.gov.

## Data Sets

- The beta.SAM.gov domains contain data that has been migrated from our legacy systems.
- The domains support two distinct types of federal awards:
  - Acquisition
  - Federal assistance.

## Data Sets

- Acquisition awards are contracts awarded under the [Federal Acquisition Regulation \(FAR\)](#).
- Federal assistance awards are grant, cooperative, loan, insurance, service, and other agreements covered by the Code of Federal Regulations, specifically [2 CFR 200](#).

## Online systems the GSA IAE manages:

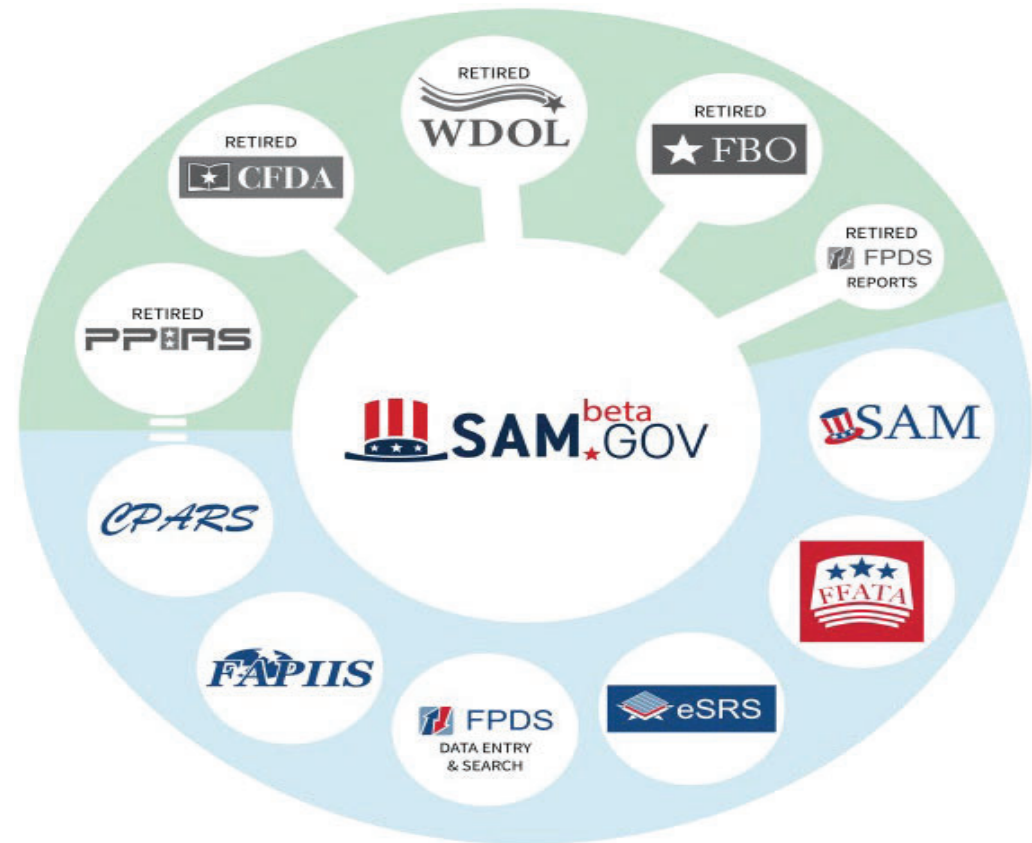
- eSRS.gov (*Electronic Subcontracting Reporting System*)

- FSRS.gov (*Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act Subaward Reporting System*)
- CPARS.gov (*Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System*)
- PPIRS.gov (*Past Performance Information Retrieval System*) (retired)

# Merging Legacy Sites

- SAM Merge:
  - Consolidates information from these systems into a single database,
  - Eliminates data overlap while sharing the data across the award lifecycle.
  - Improves efficiency for all users.

## Important Facts about the SAM.gov Transition

Core data will not change, although the user interface to search and access data is being updated.

- Data associated with existing entities will carry over to the new environment.
- User roles will also migrate, provided the user's SAM.gov account and beta.SAM.gov accounts are associated with the same email address in their login.gov account.



## Single Point of Contact

- Once the integration occurs, the system will provide a modern portal for entities to register, update, renew, and check the status of their registration in the rebranded SAM.gov.
- Federal and non-federal users will be able to search for registrations and exclusions, and entities will be able to perform service contract and BioPreferred reporting.

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## Unique Entity Identifier Update

### Government Transition from DUNS Number to New Unique Entity Identifier Extended

- By April of 2022, the federal government will stop using the DUNS number to uniquely identify entities registered in the System for Award Management (SAM).

## Unique Entity Identifier Update

### Government Transition from DUNS Number to New Unique Entity Identifier Extended

- Entities will no longer have to go to a third-party website to obtain their identifier.
- Active registrants will have their UEI assigned and viewable within SAM.gov
- This will streamline the entity identification and validation process, making it easier and less burdensome for entities to do business with the federal government.

## Unique Entity Identifier Update

### What Action Do I Need to Take?

Users are not required to take any action at this time. The IAE has shifted the UEI transition date from December 2020 to April of 2022.



## **New Security Offering for SAM.gov May 24, 2021**

Identity proofing:

- Voluntary at first/ mandatory in fiscal year 2022.
- Adds layer of security that protects you, your entity, and the government

Assistance Listings is a government-wide catalog of federal programs, projects, services, and activities. It contains financial and nonfinancial assistance programs that benefit the American public. Each listing includes information on eligibility and how to apply.



## Contract Opportunities

Contract Opportunities is a government-wide list of notices of proposed contract actions expected to exceed \$25,000. Notices include solicitations, pre-solicitations, sole source justifications, awards and other notices related to the acquisition of supplies and services.



## Contract Data

Contract Data is publicly available information about all unclassified contract actions over the micro -purchase threshold. Contract actions include definitive contracts, indefinite delivery vehicles (IDVs), delivery orders, purchase orders, modifications and other types of contract actions.





## Entity Information

Entity Registrations. Information collected from anyone (e.g., vendors, state & local governments, individuals, non-profit organizations) who wants to be considered for a federal award (acquisition awards, assistance awards, or both).

Exclusions. Exclusions identify individuals, firms, and others as ineligible from receiving certain federal awards.

## Federal Hierarchy

The federal hierarchy provides an organization hierarchy of funding and awarding departments or independent agencies, sub-tier organizations, and offices.



## Wage Determinations

Wage Determinations provide the required wage rates and fringe benefit rates that must be met on federal procurement contracts for each labor category covered by the Davis Bacon Act or the Service Contract Act as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor.
